For the Erasmus University I work as a consultant / project manager for the Erasmus Electronic Publishing Initiative (EPI). I consult, co-ordinate and manage different projects and developments leading to a University which operates more and more as an active publisher of research knowledge.

Tasks under my responsibility at the Erasmus University are:

- Co-ordination of development and implementation of several different (open source) software projects.
- Project management of the Electronic Learning Journal (ELJ) project
- ICT-Consultancy for other projects like HARVEX
- Acting as representative of the University at nationwide consultative bodies e.g. within DARE.
- Project- and ICT-consultancy at faculties and institutes within the university, especially for the Erasmus Research Institute of Management (ERIM), a well known research institute of the Rotterdam School of Management and the Rotterdam School of Economics.

For NetAdapt, my own company, my activities concentrate around the selling of a self-made product the NetAdapt Photo Database, consultancy on the area of Electronic Publishing and the archiving of digital materials at organizations other than the Erasmus University, support of running project and the management/development of smaller new projects.
